Session 1

Why sustainability matters – global trends and local action (key note)

Session 4

Session 5

Topics include the selection of the most suitable (reporting) framework; the use of technology in sustainability integration; strategic and operation alignment across the organisation; deciding on labelling & certification; engaging with value chain partners and other topics.

Session 6

Partnership opportunities: what do I need for my sustainability journey and who can I work with?

This session will focus on what it needs for you to take your sustainability journey further, to help identify support needs and to broker partnerships and collaboration for mutual benefit. You will leave with a better understanding on opportunities in sustainability, how to overcome common sustainability challenges as well as a new network of likeminded peers and organisations who can support you on your journey far beyond the Sustainability Forum.
